- Jammin' on Janesville. COVID cancelled the normal June date. However, the Chamber of Commerce decided to hold it in August. It appeared to be a success for Muskego. While we did not actually participate due to circumstances unrelated to COVID, it was a nice change to actually be able to walk around and enjoy the festivities in lieu of working in our booth.
- Drive-Thru Friday Fry. This was something new, as a response to COVID, we have never done before. The drive thru concept was a great success. It was more successful than our regular dine in fish fry's. This was probably the single most contributor to helping the lodge financially through the spring and summer. Certainly made up for Jamm'n on Janesville. Many thanks to all that helped on Friday Fish Fry.
- Dandelion Daze. We knocked this one out of the park! Because of COVID the committee decided to hold a one day event in lieu of the usual three day event. 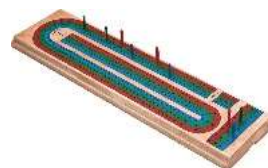
