

The next step was to obtain a contract from the sign company. This contract has now been sent down to Moose International for their review and their approval. Once the Lodge receives the contract back from Moose International, the order will be placed.

When children play a team sport, they learn that it doesn't just come down to the best player, it comes down to working as a team, accepting decisions and understanding that people have different abilities.

Team sports can also be good for a child's mental health. Children who play sports learn how to be more resilient when presented with a setback and are less likely to feel isolated.

The committee's fundraising project is the raffles at the family picnic. This year, the Fraternal Activities Committee is extremely pleased to be able to donate funds towards the Mooseheart Girls Athletic Program as well as the WOTM Scholarship & Maintenance Fund.


