Administrator Message. . .

Hi Everyone!

Summer is going fast! We're already halfway thru State Fair as I write this message. The new electronic sign and message center outside is working great! Thanks to Doug Knight and Tricia Ryan-Tellier for managing the messages and displays on the sign. I hope everyone likes our new sign!?

The big development at the lodge if everyone has not yet heard is we were audited by the State of Wisconsin Office of Charitable Gaming. This occurred when I submitted for renewal of our raffle licenses which the Office of Charitable Gaming is responsible for issuing. Apparently, I did not submit correctly and received an email asking I call their office. After answering a few questions, they decided they needed to make a visit to review how we are holding raffles. Apparently, we were not doing them in accordance with the laws for Class A and Class B raffles. The biggest change is we can no longer hold any gambling games involving dice. That includes our weekly meat raffle and all shake of the day raffles. Also, both the WOTM and Moose Riders are applying for their own raffle licenses. The law requires all proceeds must be deposited into the bank account of the organization holding the licenses. That would mean any raffles the WOTM or Riders hold for their fund raising, would need to be deposited into the lodge bank account. They cannot be deposited into their respective bank accounts. To minimize accounting headaches, it was decided to have separate raffle licenses.

Here is the broken record again! We continue to need more help and cooperation from our membership. The more we can get membership to volunteer and help out, the better our lodge becomes. Please, if you can come out and help doing just one small thing, makes life easier for all the other volunteers. One of the important areas of our lodge needing help is outdoors. Keeping our grounds looking clean. Please help with picking up trash and recyclables. If you see trash on the ground, help out by picking it up and putting it in the trash. If you see a trash can full and are able, don't be afraid to take it out to the trash dumpsters. We have additional trash can liners. Just ask a bartender. Thinking someone else will do it is not the answer to keeping our lodge clean and enjoyable.

While Horseshoe league has ended, we're still having weekly car shows with the Pit deck bar and grille open. Everyone is looking forward to our annual car show September 23rd. This an "All Hands on Deck" event needing every volunteer we can get to come out and help.

Our building continues to require maintenance. Repair to the tile floor in the kitchen should be complete by the printing of this newsletter. Then old rusty steel doors over the exterior stairwell down to the basement storage room under the hall kitchen have failed and we need another solution to covering the stairwell that allows for easy access. We're still working on plans for a new shelter with man door to cover the stairwell. Last, thought we would get to this during our last newsletter, the board will be looking at expanding the back deck off the hall. Hopefully we'll have a decision by our next newsletter.

Thomas Kronenburg of Milwaukee, Wisconsin, a member of Muskego Moose Lodge No. 1057, was summoned to receive the Pilgrim Degree of Merit, the highest honor that can be bestowed upon a member of the Moose. The conferral was held in the House of God at Mooseheart, Illinois on Saturday, June 3, 2023. The degree, currently held by less than one-half of one percent of the members of the Moose fraternity throughout the United States, Canada, and Great Britain, is the Organization's ultimate reward for exceptional devotion to the principles and ideals of caring for children and senior members, and is earned only by members who have given years of 'above-the-call-of-duty' service to the Moose and its principle philanthropic endeavors of Mooseheart, a city for children in need, located forty miles west of Chicago, and Moosehaven, a retirement community for senior members, located on the banks of the St. Johns River in Orange Park, FL. The Pilgrim Degree ceremony, traditionally held on the same day as the Commencement Exercises for Mooseheart High School, is conferred only inside Mooseheart's House of God, the magnificent multi-denominational cathedral built in 1950. Members receiving this Degree are entitled to wear a much-coveted gold blazer, which is formally presented to the honoree during a special ceremony attended by other Pilgrims, members of the higher degrees of the Moose, family, friends, community leaders, and other members of the Order. Tom's Pilgrim Presentation Ceremony is scheduled for September 30, 2023, at the Muskego Moose Lodge.


