Administrator Message. . .

Hi everyone!

Summer is Gone and Fall going fast! Where did this year go? Here I'm writing the last newsletter message for the year!

In my previous newsletter message, I explained the rules regarding gambling in the lodge according to the Wisconsin Office of Charitable Gaming. I explained we could no longer do our weekly meat raffle. Well, we found a way to continue having our meat raffle. First, the prize for winning the raffle is a \$25 gift card to Weiss Meats located down the road in Big Bend. This decision was made to eliminate any liability for keeping safe the meat we purchased and kept in the freezer. Please stop by Weiss Meats and check them out! They are also Moose members. Second, is we decided to make the game free to every Moose member once daily. If to play is free, it is not gambling according to the Office of Charitable Gaming. So please come in the lodge and play the meat raffle game. Also, any donation to the lodge is always appreciated!

Here is the broken record again! We continue to need more help and cooperation from our membership. The more we can get membership to volunteer and help-out, the better our lodge becomes. Please, if you can come out and help doing just one small thing, it makes life easier for all the other volunteers. One of the important areas of our lodge needing help is in the kitchen. If you like kitchen duties, you're the person we're looking for! Please help with keeping our lodge clean and presentable. If you see trash or recyclables laying around in the building or on the ground, help-out by picking it up and putting it in the trash. If you see a trash can full and are able, don't be afraid to take it out to the trash dumpsters. We have additional trash can liners. Just ask a bartender. Thinking someone else will do it is not the answer to keeping our lodge clean and enjoyable.

The new concrete hopefully will prevent further flooding of our basement. Next the old rusty steel doors over the exterior stairwell down to the basement storage room under the hall kitchen will be replaced with a weatherproof enclosure and door to provide much easier access to the basement. The enclosure will look like a small addition to the building. We hope to get the enclosure complete before end of this year.

The board is still looking at expanding the back deck off the hall. We were hoping to have a decision by now. My goal would be to have it completed by next spring before horseshoes begins.






