



Outgoing Administrator's Message

Hi Everyone!

It's been an honor serving as your administrator the last two and a half years. This will be my last newsletter message as I've decided to step down and let someone take the torch. Please welcome our new administrator, Lynn Martin! She officially started Feb. 1. My last day will be Feb. 28 allowing time for me to pass on all the information necessary for Lynn to take over. This doesn't mean I'm going away. Just changing my involvement in our lodge. I plan to continue helping my wife Donna with Social Quarters management and helping around our lodge.

I don't know about you, but I can sense spring is just around the corner. In my opinion, it can't come soon enough! Our lodge continues to be financially strong. We continue to make improvements. We have completed a few projects around the lodge lately. Here are some of the projects we've completed and others in the planning including updates on status.

- Upgrades to the horseshoe pits will be continuing hopefully this month. The plan is still to complete all pits before the start of the horseshoe league season.
- So far, no roof leaks detected. We'll see when spring rains finally come.
- We are waiting for Delux Heating, our HVAC contractor, to install the new thermostats and wireless sensors controlling the two rooftop units serving the Social Quarters. This will allow us to locate the sensors more efficiently for better overall temperature control.
- So far, no basement flooding since installation of the two additional downspouts on the roof gutter at the southwest corner of the main kitchen. However, again Spring rains will let us know if we've succeeded.

The following projects are next in line for continued improvements to our lodge.

- New carpet in the hall. We have finalized what we want done in the hall and await receiving a final quote from John Beringer and Dave Skrobis whom we have chosen to do the installation.
- Expansion of the exterior deck on the south side of the banquet hall. This is still on the back burner. My hopes are we will have enough money after the hall carpet is replaced to start this project and have it complete before we host the Wisconsin State tournament this coming August.

Here is the never-ending broken record!

- We continue to need more help and cooperation from our membership. The more we can get membership to volunteer and help, the better our lodge becomes. The board continues to work on a list of tasks/chores to be taken care of that don't get the regular attention needed. A small white board in our entrance lobby lists a few things we need help with. These should be rather easy things most any member could step up and do. We will continue to update this list of volunteer opportunities.
- If everyone could come out and help doing just one small thing, it would make life easier for all the other volunteers. One of the important areas of our lodge always needing help is in the kitchen. Thanks to a few people who stepped up, we have been able to continue our Wednesday wings, Thursday Taco night and two Friday fish fry's a month.
- Please help us with keeping our lodge clean and presentable. If you see trash or recyclables laying around in
 the building or ESPECIALLY on the grounds, help out by picking it up and putting it in the trash. If you see a
 trash can full and are able, don't be afraid to take it out to the trash dumpsters. We have additional trash can
 liners. Just ask a bartender. Thinking someone else will do it is not the answer to keeping our lodge clean and
 enjoyable.

Heart of the Community Scholarship Program Applications Now Available









Each year Lodges are required to hold an election of Board of Directors for the new Moose Year. (Moose Fiscal Year is May 1 -April 30). During the month of February, a Nominating Committee will be appointed by President Tracy Manz to determine the slate of Board of Directors for the 2025-2026 year. Nominations will be accepted for the offices of President, Vice President, Chaplain, Treasurer and 3-Year Trustee. Some of the duties of these offices are:

PRESIDENT: Appoints committee chairmen, non-elected positions, presides over the Board of Directors meeting and Membership meetings, signs checks and reports in general, and is the leader of his Lodge.

VICE PRESIDENT: Serves as acting President, when necessary, attends all meetings, assist the President in preserving order and decorum in the Lodge and visits members who are ill.

CHAPLAIN: Serves on the Financial Review committee, attends all Lodge and Board of Directors meetings and presides at meeting in the absence of the President and Vice President

TREASURER: Secures duplicate deposit slips made for all Lodge bank accounts, signs all properly authorized checks and shall assist Administrator when necessary.

3-YEAR TRUSTEE: Takes inventory of Lodge merchandise for resale, examines, and approves all bills for payment, verifies books and safeguards equipment and assets of the Lodge and attends all meetings.
