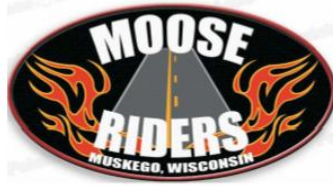

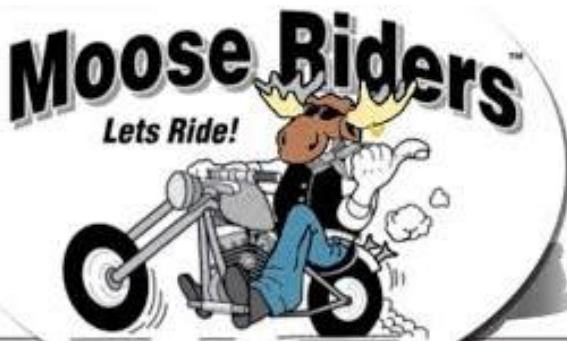

These are all great independent living skills that our kids will need once they graduate and move on from Mooseheart.

Our gifts will feed a home of 10 girls or 10 boys for a month and support our Mooseheart community in this fun adventure!

The committee's fundraising project was Wing Wednesday, from the proceeds, a generous donation will be made to the Moose Charities for this very special undertaking.
