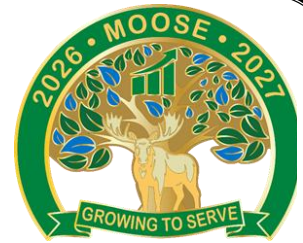

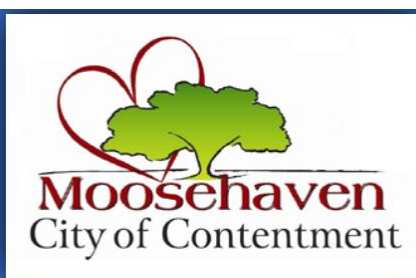

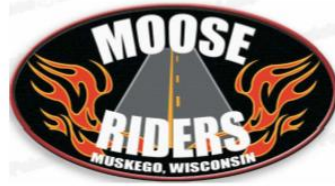

Team sports can also be good for a child's mental health. Children who play sports learn how to be more resilient when presented with a setback and are less likely to feel isolated.

The committee's fundraising project was the Bake Sale & Food Sales at Junk-in-the-Trunk event. This year, the Fraternal Activities Committee is extremely pleased to be able to donate funds towards the Mooseheart Girls Athletic Program as well as the WOTM Scholarship & Maintenance Fund.
