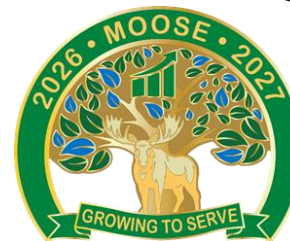

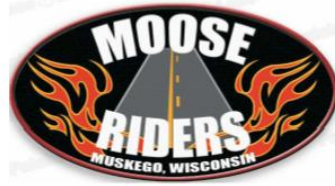

2026 Moose Rider Mileage

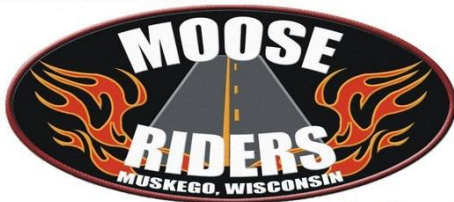
There will be three categories worth money

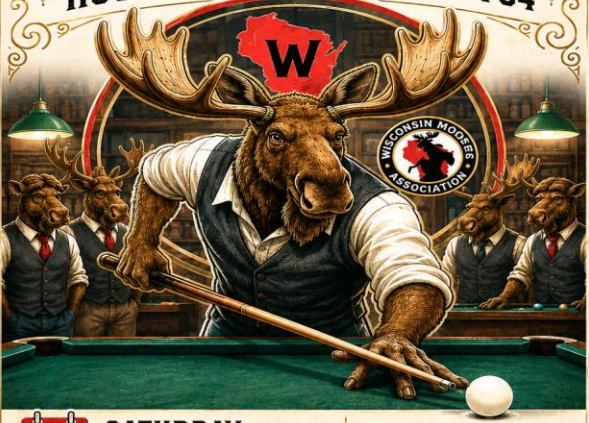
